Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

As we celebrate the great Solemnity of Pentecost, we recall the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and the birth of the Church. This gift of the Holy Spirit continues to be poured out upon the Church and upon us. I chose Pentecost intentionally as the day when we reach an important milestone in our two-year Growing Disciples planning process with the announcement about our parishes and churches. Thank you for your participation, your feedback, and your advice which have helped me make the decisions that are announced today.

I spent time in further prayer, study and discernment over the recommendations that were made to me by the extensive process of consultation which occurred. I have reached the following decision regarding St. Louis, St. John the Evangelist, Immaculate Conception, and St. Mary's.

St. Louis in Princeton, St. John the Evangelist in Walnut, Immaculate Conception in Ohio, and St. Mary in Tiskilwa will be merged to become one parish, with a primary worship site at St. Louis. Immaculate Conception in Ohio and St. Mary in Tiskilwa will not be in use. Masses may continue during the process of implementing this change which is expected to be completed over the next 24 months.

In the meantime, Msgr. James Kruse will remain pastor of St. Louis Parish. Fr. Thomas Shaw will remain pastor of St. John the Evangelist in Walnut and Immaculate Conception in Ohio. Fr. Scott Potthoff will continue as pastor of St. Mary in Tiskilwa. We continue to pray for Fr. Shaw's health.

Website cdop.org The implementation phase will begin in all parishes on July 1, 2024. I ask Msgr. Kruse to lead the implementation effort in cooperation with Fr. Shaw and Fr. Potthoff. In order to adapt to this merger of parishes, it will be necessary to determine the new Mass schedule. I ask you to work with your priests to arrange a schedule of four weekend Masses between the two churches of the parish.

I am asking every parish to engage in a process of renewal. Every parish is asked to evaluate its schedule of Masses, its programs of pastoral care and evangelization. I challenge every parish to be more intense in cultivating disciples. More information about this call to become a more vibrant parish will be released in the coming months.

I ask for your continued prayers and continued cooperation as we work together to strengthen and renew our Diocese in this new apostolic age. Know that I pray for you daily. May the Holy Spirit bless all our efforts to Grow Disciples.
